- Yves Saint Laurent was a french designer. He founded his brand in 1961 after being dismissed from Dior.
- He is known for his famous "Le Smoking" tuxedo for women.
- His designs took women out of the dresses they were wearing and put them in pant suits, pea coats, and tuxedos which was not seen before.
- Saint Laurent was the first to launch a ready to wear label as well as using fabric used for menswear in womenswear.
- He blurred the lines between femininity and masculinity.

If money Were not an issue..





Saint Laurent's collection beautifies me internally and externally by ..

- Creating a feeling of comfort yet confidence. Since his designs are very tailored they emphasize body parts like the shoulders and waist they give off an hourglass figure.

- Internally, YSL evokes a feeling of extreme confidence, sexiness, and elegance. When one feels confident in themselves, the clothing becomes a reflection of that feeling.
