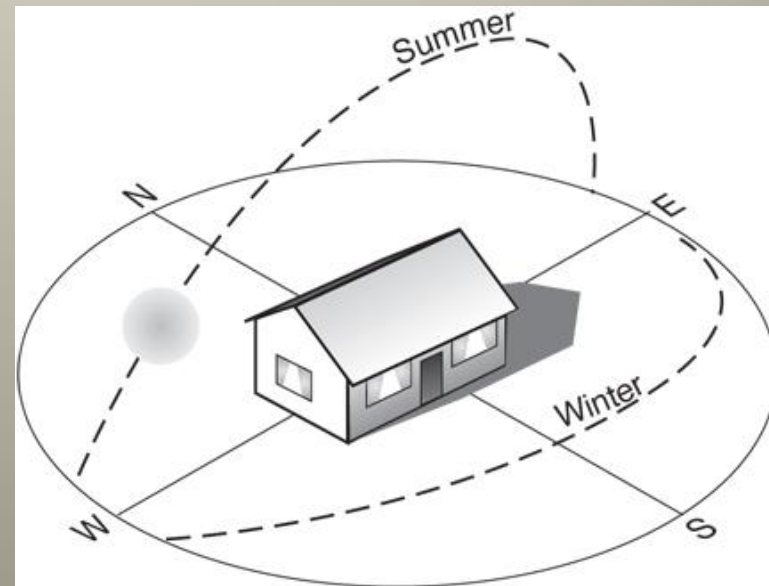
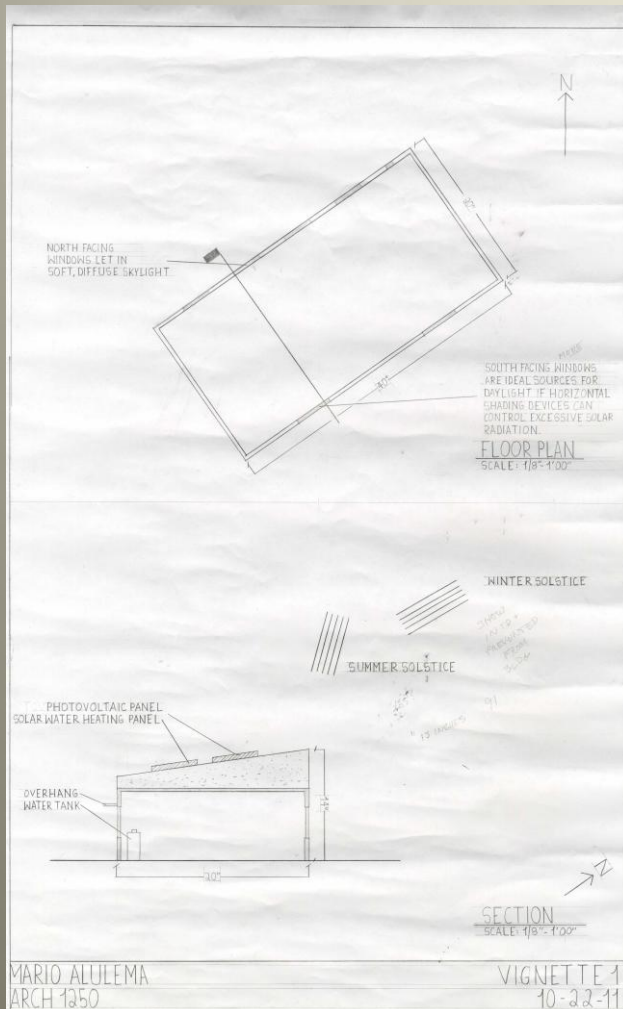

Vignette 1: Solar Orientation

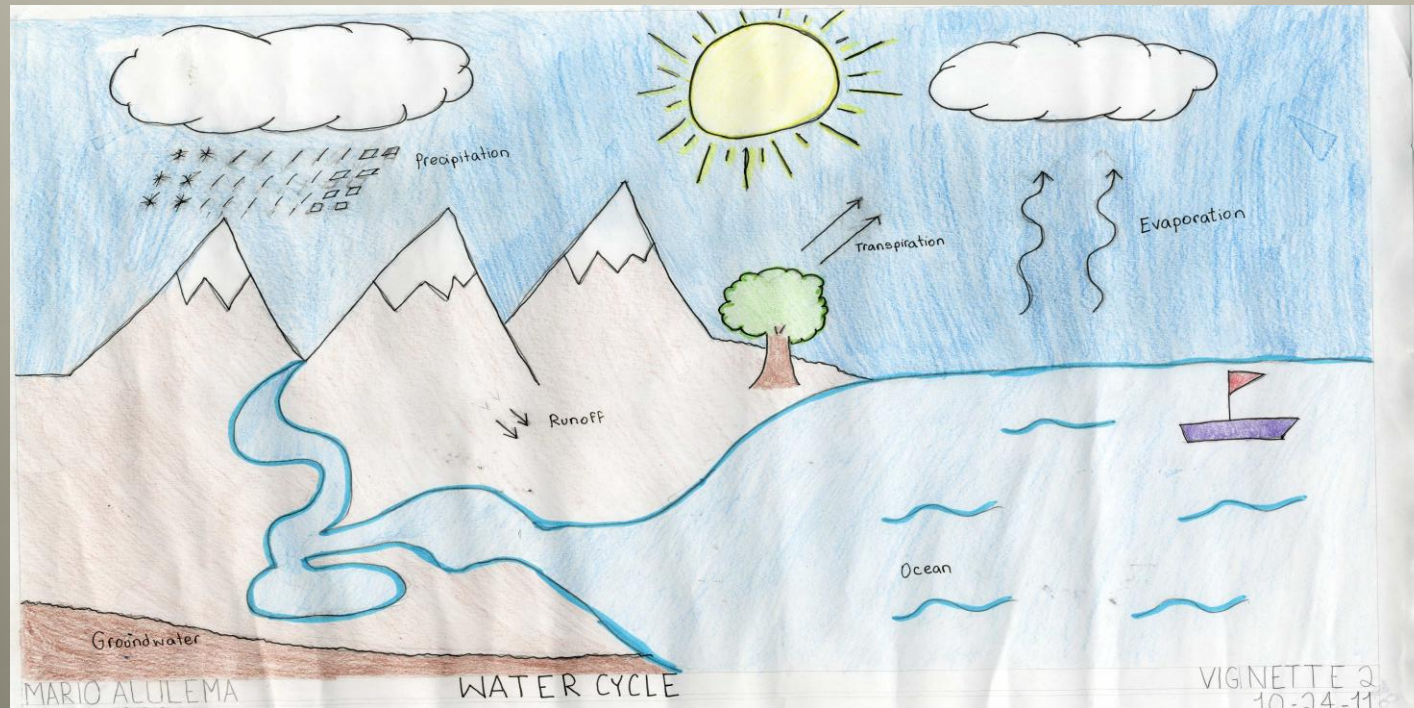
The objective of this vignette was to design a proper roof for an office space. Also, students had to orient the space in order to take full advantage of solar radiation.
