

Infographic: Computer Security

Each individual student should submit one completed infographic poster.

Each submission should be unique – do not share content with other students.

Use the following approach to complete your assignment:

- 1. Review the class slides, readings, and your class notes for the topics covered in Week 1 (Introduction to Information Security, and The Need for Security).
- 2. Choose a subject of interest to you in the scope of the Week 1 topics (above).
- 3. Organize your thoughts on an important message to share with employees on the subject you chose.
- 4. Gather supporting information (statistics, charts, quotes, etc.) in support of the message for your subject.
- 5. Design an infographic on one page (dimensions may be any size you like) which communicates your message for the subject you chose. You may consider infographics from the poster areas of SANS (https://www.sans.org/security-resources/posters/all) or any cybersecurity conference, association (OWASP, ISACA, CERT, MITRE, etc.), government agency, or other source as examples of the type of layout and style you would like to use.
- 6. Prepare that one page infographic using PowerPoint, Google Slides, Canva.com, Prezi, or any similar tool capable of saving a .PDF file.
- 7. Save your infographic as a .PDF file with the file name in the format (replace <YOURFULLNAME> with your full name):
 - "CST2410-OL20-Su21_<YOURFULLNAME>_Assignment#01.PDF"
- 8. Submit your .PDF file infographic to this assignment (Assignment #01 Infographic: Computer Security) in the Assignments folder of the Content area on Blackboard.
