My t-shirt was inspired by current events that recently transpired. I wanted this shirt to symbolize not only how society views me, but how I view myself because my perception of me is also very important. The basic background of my t-shirt was a green, purple and blue circle design tie dye. The color purple symbolizes luxury, mystery and spirituality. The color blue symbolizes trust and intelligence. Green symbolizes wealth, nature, growth and stability. Together it creates a color wheel of seeping emotions and it shows that I myself see it blue as sadness, purple as the panic and green as the color that calms the wave.

On the left side of my t-shirt I created a dripping red heart and on the inside it reads "tender", meaning I have a tender heart. I'm a very compassionate person and that heart symbolizes how easy it is for me to feel compassionate for others. It's negative side effect is how easily I let others manipulate and take advantage of that kindness.
