# My Role

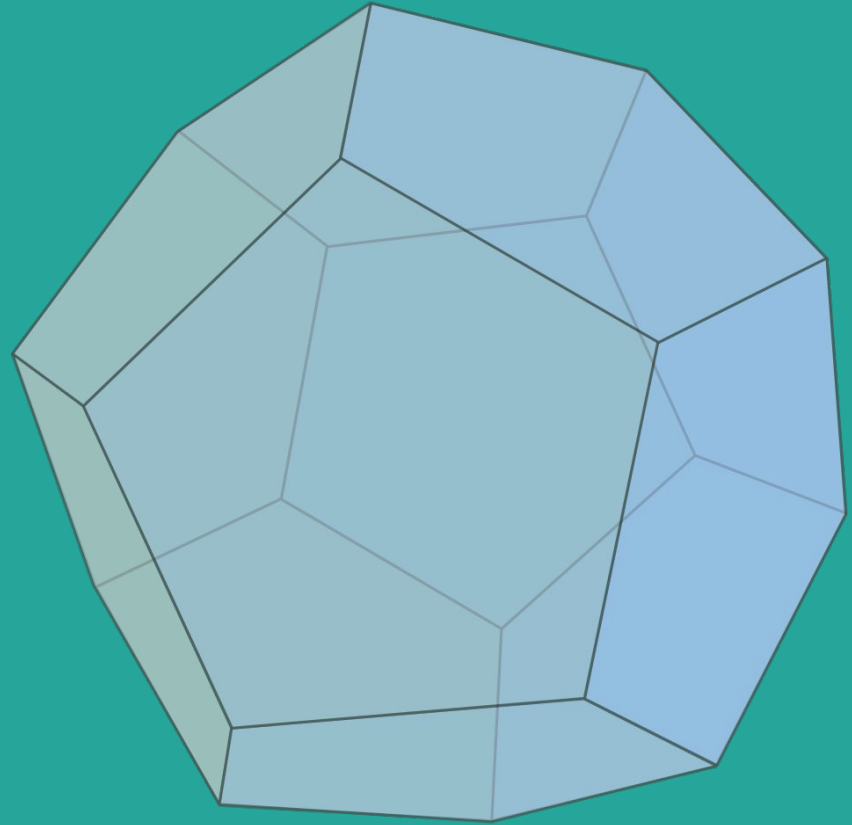
