- Assessment: Attendance, Homework, 4 Tests, and Final Exam
  - Your Course Average( $\mathbf{G}$ ) is determined by attendance grade( $\mathbf{A}$ ), homework grade( $\mathbf{H}$ ), test grade( $\mathbf{T}$ ) and final exam grade( $\mathbf{E}$ ).
  - $-\mathbf{A} = \text{Half the count of attendance}$ . That is,
    - \* Each attendance is counted as 0.5 point.
    - \* Attending late or leaving early will discount the attendance grade of that day to 0.25 point.
    - \* Attending late AND leaving early on the same day will reduce the attendance grade of that day to 0 point.
  - H = The average of all but one lowest homework grade. Each homework is graded on a 100-point scale.
  - T = The average of the test grades. Each test is graded on a 100-point scale.
    - \* If you are NOT **Excessively Absent**, your **T** is the average where 1 lowest test grade is dropped.
    - \* If you ARE Excessively Absent, your T is simply the average of all your test grades.
  - $-\mathbf{F}$  = The final exam grade, which is on a 100-point scale.
  - G is the **Highest** of the following 3 calculations
    - \*  $\mathbf{G}_1 = \mathbf{A} + 0.1\mathbf{H} + 0.55\mathbf{T} + 0.25\mathbf{E}$
    - \*  $\mathbf{G}_2 = \mathbf{A} + 0.1\mathbf{H} + 0.45\mathbf{T} + 0.35\mathbf{E}$
    - \*  $\mathbf{G}_3 = \mathbf{A} + 0.2\mathbf{H} + 0.45\mathbf{T} + 0.25\mathbf{E}$
  - You can **Pass** the course if your performance meets one of the following
    - \*  $\mathbf{G} \ge 60$ ;  $\mathbf{E} \ge 40$ .
    - \*  $G \ge 50$ ;  $E \ge 60$

The criteria implies that everyone is required to take the final exam and receives at least a 40 on **E** regardless of how well your performance is during the semester. However, This minimum final exam grade 40 is not sufficient to guarantee a passing grade for the course.

- If your performance meets the passing criteria, your letter grade is determined by G according to the following table

	$\mathbf{A}$	В	$\mathbf{C}$
+	X	87	77
	93	83	73
_	90	80	70

\* You receive a **D** if you pass the course but doesn't meet the **C**- criterion.

## • Homework Policy

## • Test/Exam Policy

- There are 4 tests and 1 final exam throughout the entire semester.
- Every student is expected to sit in every test/exam session. No make-up of any of the 4 tests will be given.
- A test/exam review sheet, which covers all materials of the actual test, will be provided at least one weak before the test day. Note that the actual test/exam does NOT contain all the materials at the review sheet.
- You need to bring a calculator to test/exam for your OWN use. No sharing of calculators in any test/exam.
- Everyone should be carrying your university ID card to any test/exam. You may be asked to show your ID card during your test/exam.
- Every test/exam is started at the beginning of the class. If you are late, you must try your test
  in the remaining time.
