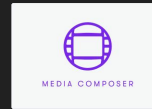

Issues that came up

I did not have as much time as expected to work on everything because of issues that came up.

Not everyone was available during recording times.

I used different cameras to record but 2 of them had a bluish preset and I forgot to change it. I didn't really have the time to actually color grade any of the footage.

I also struggled with syncing audio with the video because the audio was not fully put together it was in chunks and then I had to line all the pieces with the videos I had.

Issues

I had a lot of footage to work with. My rough cut was around 25-30 minutes long. It was hard to narrow it down because I thought everything was important and it needed to be in my video.

I had to make hard decisions and decide what to keep and what to just take out completely. I didn't like that part but at the end it came out good. I would definitely keep working on it more and make an extended version.

What would I do if I had more time.

I would have color graded my footage. I was not able to do so because a lot of my time was focused on deciding what needed to be cut and how everything could be put together in a shorter time

I would have liked to have gotten more unique and detailed shots of the musicians.

There were bird sounds in the background of one of the interviews audio. I did not realize it until I was editing.

I would dedicate more time on getting more shots.

I would have also edited the video in a more aesthetic way.

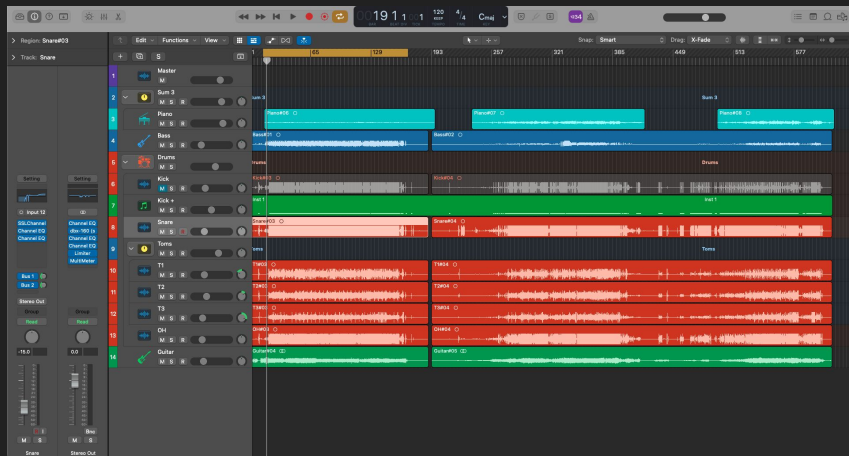
