To be eligible for a scholarship, students must:

- · Be U.S. citizens or permanent resident aliens
- Be enrolled full time (at least 12 credits per semester) in the BS program in Applied Mathematics or Biomedical Informatics, or the AS program in Chemical Technology or Computer Science
- Complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form and demonstrate financial need
- Demonstrate academic potential:
 - For current students, a cumulative GPA at least 3.0
 - For **entering transfer students** with an associate degree, a **GPA of at least 3.2**
 - For entering freshmen: 85% high school average and 12 CPI credits, including at least two Science and three English credits
 - Meet eligibilty for pre-calculus or higher math
