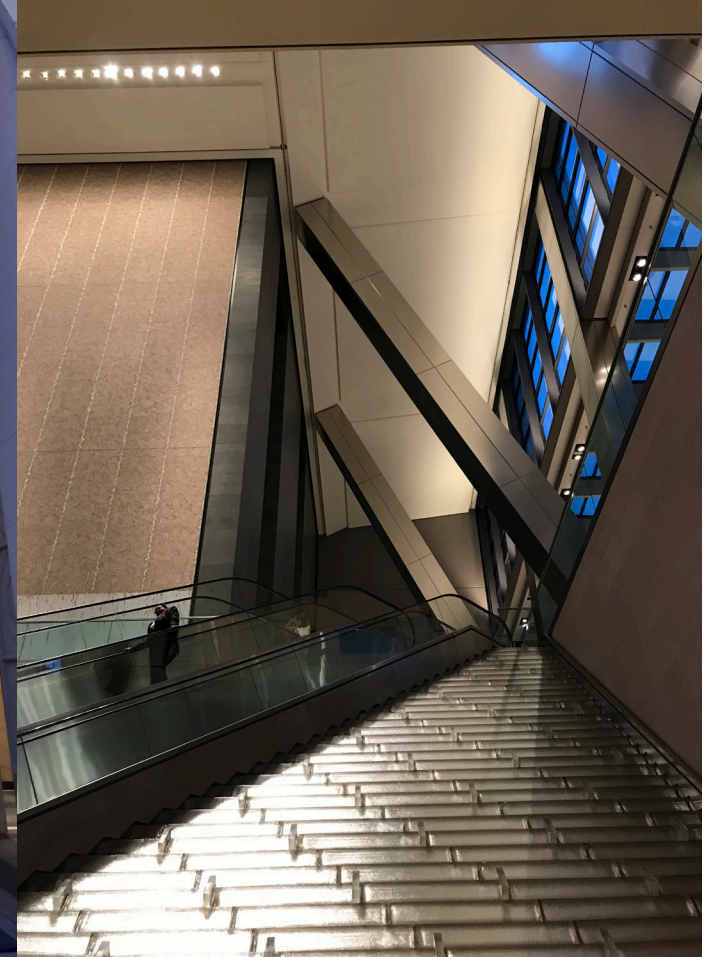
Facade: Steel and Glass

Building Time: 3 years

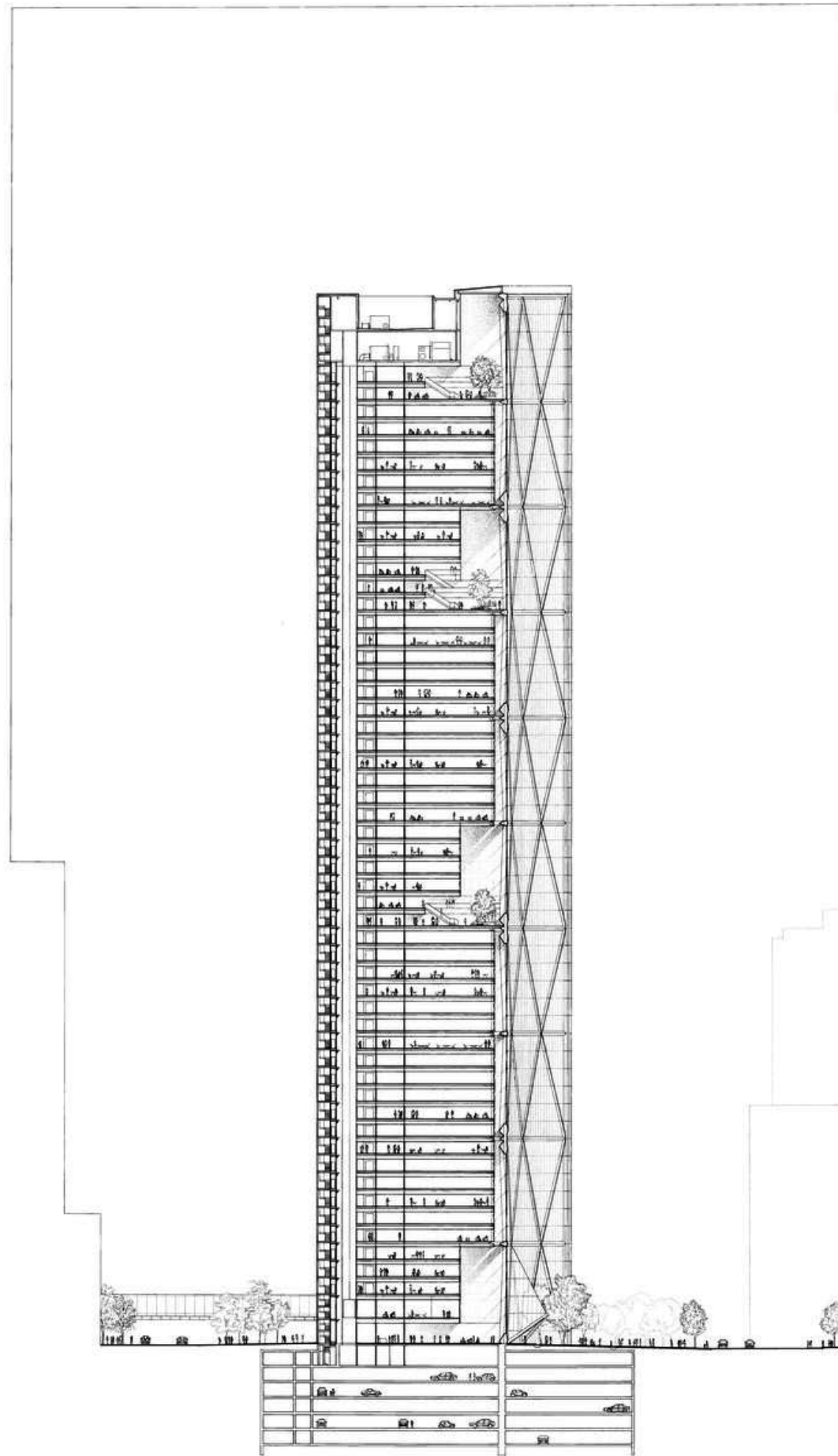
Program: Office
