- Wolf and Red confront Grandmother.

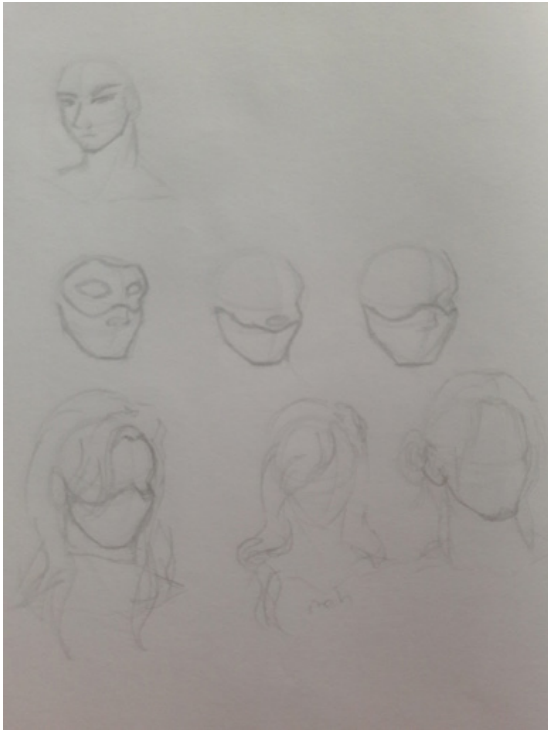
