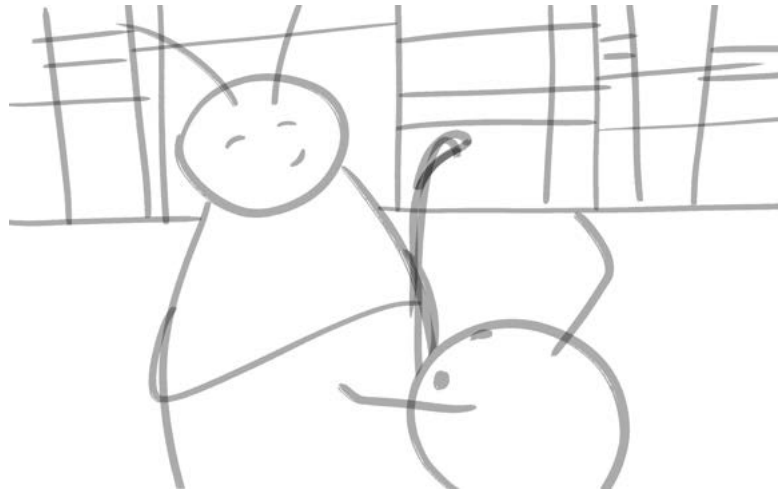

THE ANT & THE GRASSHOPPER BY AESOP

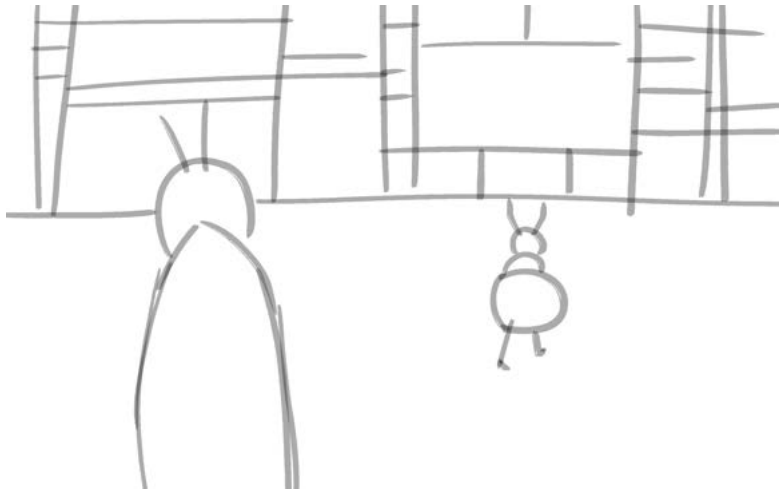
