




Amazon's Earnings 2016 through 2017

- 1. The time series shows the net revenue of Amazon.com's e-commerce and service sales from 2004 to 2017, in billion US dollars.
- 2. In the last reported year, the company's net revenue was almost 178 billion U.S. dollars, up from 135.99 billion US dollars in 2016.
- 3. 2016 to 2017 had the largest net sales revenue increase.




