





The zig zag chair was designed without legs. It used four wooden plate. It was designed in 1934 by Gerrit Rietveld. The actual goal of the design was to create a functional form which does not displace space but allows it to be perceived as a continuum; indeed, of Rietveld's entire body of work the "Zig-Zag" represents the most economical example of such a form.
