















Gerrit Rietveld Steltman Chair:

The stunning 1963 Steltman
Chair was originally
commissioned by Steltman
jewelers in The Hague, as
seating for betrothed couples
perusing wedding rings. In fact
only two were made, and the
surviving one – now in
Amsterdam's Rijksmuseum was used as the basis for this
limited edition.

The design is broken up into three simple shapes that appear to rest up against and on top of each other. These sections are all upholstered in leather, the original material used to cover the chair.
