










A STRUCTURE





THE GEHRY RESIDENCE IS A PERSONAL REDEFINED HOME THAT FRANK GEHRY AND HIS WIFE BOUGHT AND REMODELLED. THE HOME IS LOCATED IN SANTA MONICA, CALIFORNIA. THE PROJECT YEAR WAS 1978. WHEN GEHRY FIRST MOVED INTO THE HOME HE KNEW HE HAD TO REDESIGN THE HOUSE. FRANK GEHRY DESIGNS USUALLY SYMBOLIZE DECONSTRUCTIVISM AND THIS IS WHAT HE WANTED TO PORTRAY IN THIS HOUSE. HE KEPT MOST OF THE HOUSE INTACT AND ADDED ON HIS OWN PIECES GIVING THE HOME A NEW AND UNIQUE STYLE.
