All Summary-Reaction Papers must follow the APA format explained in the departmental writing style statement. In the first paragraph, note the name of the article, author, publication and date and subject of the article. In the following paragraph(s) summarize the contents of the selected article. Note the relevance to food procurement in a foodservice setting. In the concluding paragraph, discuss your own viewpoint (reaction) by agreeing or disagreeing with the author, noting relevant examples or appropriate anecdotes. Staple (no paperclips) a photocopy or printout of the article after the assignment in the upper left hand corner. **Photocopies only - original articles not accepted!**
