Guidelines for original jpeg or Apple Phone or Camera Raw image file to be approved by the instructor **before*** use in a project.

Graphic files must have "File Info" Data: camera and shot information plus Origin Date Created information data embedded in file.

*Consult with Professor Carr if your capture device produces a special file format.

- (1) Native camera file format*.
- (2) Native width, height and resolution.
- (3) Native color mode and embedded profile.
- (4) Simple, clear colored objects with red, green and blue colors.
- (5) Appropriate graphic for your professional portfolio.

Project 1

Must be original student work.

Students should submit qualified files during Session 02 and 03 to receive a written approval of the file *before 5 PM on Session 03.

Project 2

May be file approved for Project 1

Students should submit qualified files during Session 05 and 06 to receive a written approval of the file *before 5 PM on Session 06.

Project 3

May be file approved for Project 1

Students should submit qualified files during Session 09 to receive a written approval of the file *before 5 PM on Session 09.

Project 4

Must be original student work.

Files used for Projects 1, 2, 3 can NOT be used.

Students should submit qualified files during Session 11 and 12 to receive a written approval of the file *before 5 PM on Session 12.
