In the short term, this enabled the Soviet Union to punch above its economic weight as a military power. By the 1980s, however, technology and information had become the Soviet Achilles heel. The Soviet Union had also something called Warsaw Pact which was the Soviet Union alliance and the United States Economic alliance was NATO. This alliance was also a military alliance which was made to help get rid of the Soviet Union and I can tell that it worked it doing so. Now we are in the middle of our presentation.
